

Can I book in a trial class?

Create your account, add student/s and click on 'Register for classes'

You will find a list of classes available for each student based on age. Under each class, a link is available labelled 'schedule trial'. Choose a date you wish to trial in the drop box. You will receive confirmation via email.

How do I pay?

All classes are charged on a **term-by-term basis**. Once enrolment is confirmed, your account will be updated with a statement showing the amount owing, which can be viewed on the **homepage of your parent portal**. Further details can be found in the enrolment information on **page 8**.

Age Groups

Age groups are determined based on a student's age as of January 1st of the enrolment year. Please note that this is not based on the age a student will turn later in the year.



FEES & PAYMENTS

PAYMENT

ADC only accepts the following payment methods:

- Direct Deposit/bank transfer
- Credit/Debit Card (available via the Dance Studio Pro/ Parent Portal)
- Cash (payment must be correct amount in an envelope labelled with student name)

PAYMENT OF FEES:

- Fees are charged on a term basis. Once enrolled, full term fees for all classes including private lessons will be invoiced to your account and must be paid prior to the due date.
- If full payment has not been received 7 days after the due date, a \$5 late fee will be automatically applied to your account for each week it goes unpaid. Extensions on payment must be discussed and agreed upon with ADC Staff.
- If fees are outstanding, restrictions may be applied to students attending class until payment is received.
- All amounts paid should match the amount on the invoice. Reference of invoice number is required for payment. Partial payments must be discussed prior to payments being made.
- A costume deposit is added to all Term 3 fees and any balance of the actual cost invoices separately in Term 4. All costumes are payable once ordering has commenced. A due date to advise of your child's non-participation is advised in term 3. Where we are not advised by this date, all costumes costs are payable by you.
- There will be no classes during public or school holidays unless advised otherwise. Term fees will be calculated to exclude these dates, with the exception of those paying the unlimited class payment.
- All active enrolments will automatically continue into each new term. Should you decide to not continue into a new term, written notification via email must be given by the end of the previous term.
- ADC reserves its rights to commence debt recovery through a Debt Collection Agency where a student leaves without paying their fees.
- Invoices will continue to be sent if notification of a withdrawal of enrollment has not formally been received.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I trial a class before enrolling?

All new students can take advantage of a free trial lesson before committing to a class. This ensures that the class is a good fit for both you and your child, and that they will enjoy it. Register your interest today, and we will contact you as soon as possible to schedule your free trial lesson.

How is information relayed to Parents & Students?

We rely on email and social media to share important information, so it's essential that we have your most up-to-date email address and that you check your inbox regularly. We also post updates on our social media channels, so be sure to like us on Facebook and follow us on Instagram to stay informed.

What do I wear to class?

Jazz/Tap: There is no compulsory uniform for jazz or tap classes, so your child can wear what they feel comfortable in. Leotards and tights are a great option, and tutus are a fun choice for younger dancers. Please avoid loose clothing or long pants, as they can pose a tripping hazard.

Ballet: A leotard and tights are required (skirts are optional). Hair must be pulled back into a neat ponytail or bun.

For all dance classes and age groups, hair must be securely tied up.

Appropriate dance shoes are necessary, but for the first trial class, your child can wear any comfortable footwear. ADC uniform items are also available for purchase.

What else do I need to bring to class?

- A water bottle.
- Correct Footwear

All enrolment information can be altered after trials, so please tick all classes you wish to trial to secure your spot or contact us at hello@andersondance.com.au to discuss enrolment.

Written notification is required to terminate enrolment. If no notice is received, you will continue to be invoiced for classes until you contact us at hello@andersondance.com.au.

Do I need to attend classes regularly?

It is essential that classes are attended consistently. Consistent attendance is crucial for progress. When students miss classes regularly, it becomes challenging for them to catch up on missed material, and it can also disrupt the flow of the class for other students.

How do I pay?

All classes are charged on a **term-by-term basis**. Once enrolment is confirmed, your account will be updated with a statement showing the amount owing, which can be viewed on the **homepage of your parent portal**. Further details can be found in the enrolment information on **page 8**.

Can parents watch the class?

You are welcome to come and watch but we ask that you please stay behind the mirrors and keep noise to a minimum.

Is it compulsory to do competitions?

Performance Team - It is optional whether students dance in troupes at competitions. If students intend on joining our "A TEAM", both the student and parent need to understand that, to reach the competition standard, a commitment must be made. All performance team classes and rehearsals must be attended and a troupe commitment form must be signed by student and parent at the beginning of the year. Students missing classes and rehearsals will not be able to remain in the troupe.

Please ask us for more information if you are interested in joining our Performance Team.

Private Lessons – This is optional also. All private lesson students are able to enter solo dances for competitions if they wish in consultation with their private lesson teacher. Again, full commitment is required in all aspects of competition work, including attendance at private lessons, practise at home and allowing for costume requirements. Solos are great for students of any age to gain self-esteem, confidence and performance skills to further their dancing careers.

What classes do I need to do to qualify for the Performance Team?

** Please note to qualify for the U10 Performance Team all students must participate in 1 Jazz class & 1 Technique class of another style per week.

**To qualify for the U12, U14 & Pre-Professional Performance Team all students must participate in 1 Jazz class & 1 Ballet class per week.

Do I have to practice?

To improve, regular practice is essential—especially when exams, competitions, or the end-of-year concert are coming up. All dancers should aim to practice at home each week and work on their flexibility daily. This will help them build skills, improve their technique, and reach their dance goals.

How do I choose what class to enrol in?

TERMS & CONDITIONS

By enrolling with **Anderson Dance Company (ADC)**, families agree to uphold a high standard of behaviour, respect, and professionalism at all times. Parents/guardians agree to support and ensure their child understands and follows the **Student Code of Conduct**.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students must behave in a **respectful, honest, and supportive** manner at all times.
 - Negative comments, comparisons, or disrespectful behaviour towards dancers or teachers will not be tolerated.
 - Disrespectful, uncooperative, or aggressively competitive behaviour from **students or parents** may result in removal from ADC.
 - Dance classes are both **educational and enjoyable**, with an emphasis on discipline, respect, and positive classroom etiquette to ensure a safe and welcoming environment for all.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

Students must:

- Use appropriate language at all times (no foul, negative, or insulting language).
- Treat staff, teachers, parents, and fellow students with respect.
- Listen to and follow teacher instructions. Ongoing disruptive or disrespectful behaviour may result in **permanent removal from classes**, following parent consultation. No refunds will be issued.
- Not exchange private contact details with teachers or communicate privately via social media.
- Support a **strict anti-bullying policy**, which applies both inside and outside the studio. All students have the right to feel safe and happy. Any concerns should be raised with a teacher or parent.

BULLYING POLICY

- ADC operates under a **zero-tolerance policy** for bullying and harassment of any kind.
- Students are encouraged to support one another and build positive friendships.
- If bullying is witnessed, it must be reported to a teacher or parent.
- Students are encouraged to be “**upstanders**”—to speak up or step in to help stop bullying when it occurs.

CANCELLATION & WITHDRAWAL OF ENROLMENT

ADC reserves the right to cancel a student's enrolment due to:

- Non-payment or ongoing late payment of fees without prior arrangement
- Physical or verbal abuse of staff or students by a parent or child

Withdrawal from enrolment must be submitted **via email only**.
Invoices will continue to be issued until written notice is received.

PARENT / GUARDIAN EXPECTATIONS

Parents and guardians are expected to model respectful behaviour at all times.

- Arrive **15 minutes early** for classes and rehearsals to allow preparation time.
- Notify staff of late arrivals or absences.
- Ensure children arrive and leave safely (accompany younger children inside).
- Inform staff of illness or injury. Injured students are encouraged to attend and observe where appropriate.
- Use respectful language and maintain a positive, supportive attitude.
- Trust the professional judgement of ADC staff. Disrespectful or disruptive behaviour may result in removal from ADC with no refund.
- Teachers are not available to discuss matters during or between classes.




